Obtain your BSN and pass the NCLEX exam. Apply for RN licensure through your State Board of Nursing.



Find employment as a pediatric RN and seek your Certified Pediatric Nurse (CPN) credential from PNCB when you meet eligibility.



Explore opportunities to lead within your organization. Pursue your Master of Science in Nursing degree or a Master's in Healthcare or Business Administration.



Advance in your career with entry-level executive roles. Pass your Certified in Executive Nursing Practice (CENP) exam through the American Organization for Nursing Leadership.



Explore national mentoring and leadership development programs to grow your skills and network.
